



# Three year plan

CMQ's Three Year Rail Network Plan indicates where on our line we intend to take steps to discontinue operations in the next three years. This plan is kept up to date and also indicates for each of our lines our intent to continue operations.

Pursuant to Section 141 of the Canada Transportation Act, Central Maine & Quebec Railway Canada (CMQ) has updated its Three-Year Rail Network Plan.

**The Plan consists of two schedules:**

**Schedule A** is a comprehensive list of those lines on which, within the next three years, CMQ intends to take steps to discontinue.

**Schedule B** is comprised of a Map. It is included to graphically illustrate CMQ's rail network and to provide general information only about CMQ's Network Plan. A line designated as "To Discontinue" means that CMQ intends to discontinue operating the line if it is not transferred.

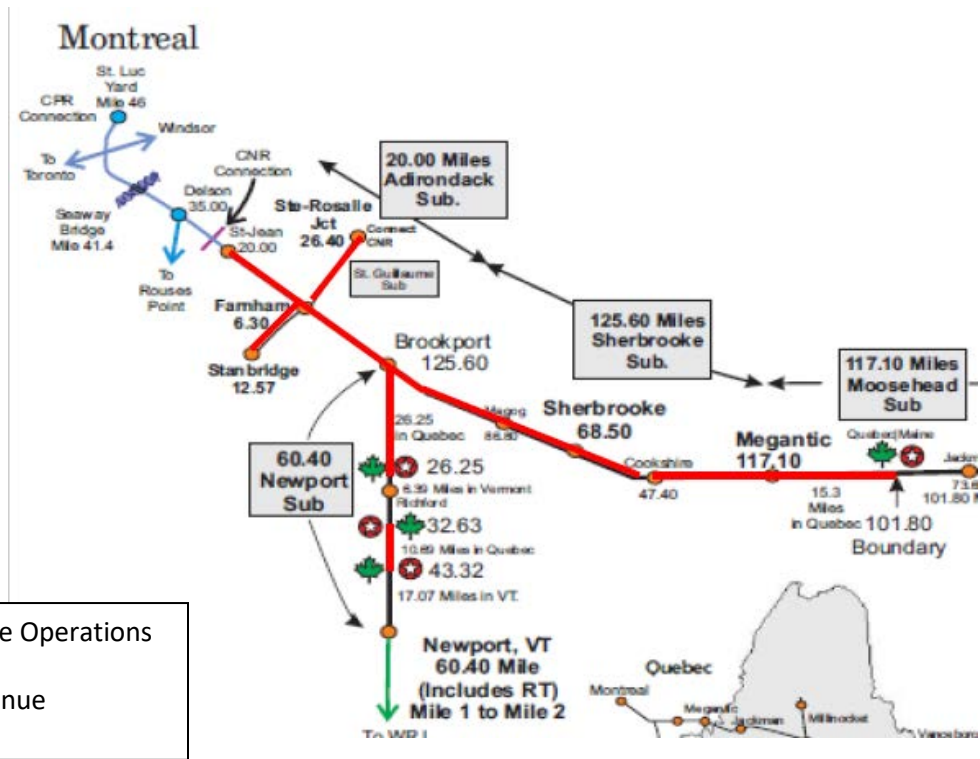
